



MEMBERS ELIGIBLE TO CONTEST THE PRESIDENTIAL AND COMMITTEE ELECTIONS TO BE HELD DURING THE

34TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

to be held on Saturday 1st June 2019 at 13:30 hours at the Lawrence Darmanin Range, First Floor, Clock Tower Block, Tigne' Point TP01

Statute Clause 4.1.3 states that "Only those persons who have been full members of the Association for not less than five (5) consecutive years are eligible to contest Association presidency. In the case of Committee elections, candidates would need to have been Association members for at least three (3) consecutive years at the time of their candidature."

Previously we published a general list of members who were eligible to contest the elections for the posts of President and Committee member. However, this is no longer permissible under General Data Protection Regulations which came into effect on 25 May 2018.

Consequently, members who wish to contest the elections are required to check their own records and verify their eligibility with the AMACS office prior to submitting the nominations.
